WORLD ELEPHANT DAY

Elephants Alive celebrated World Elephant Day on August 12th by giving a puppet show to 700 pupils at Maseke Primary School. The delight on the children's faces was inspirational. They loved the different puppet characters, meeting the team behind the show and, most importantly, the message. 'Why do we think we need to protect elephants and rhinos?' Elephants Alive were proud to partner with the Black Mamba Anti-Poaching Unit, and we all enjoyed bringing the puppets to the children, decking their classroom out in colour and celebrating the unique opportunity to share our world with elephants. What a privilege...what a day to remember! An exciting new partnership has been forged between Elephants Alive and Wild Shots Educational Outreach, an organisation which aims to engage previously disadvantaged young people in nature and conservation through photography. have a magical mix of kids, cameras - and elephants! Eight children, aged 10-12, from the Maseke and Mshishimale rural communities, joined our first residential programme, spending an inspirational three days in the bush at Sefapane

Camp near Phalaborwa. The first two days were spent learning all about digital photography, followed by game drives to practice their new photographic skills. This was the first time for some of the children to see big game,

including a thrilling close encounter with a bull elephant. On the third day they had a unique opportunity to photograph three elephant collaring operations. Phalaborwa Mine is bordered by the Klaserie and Balule



Association of Private Nature Reserves and the Kruger National Park. Although this huge mine is fenced, elephants have broken through the barriers, causing potential danger to both the mine, its staff and the elephants. Three of the elephants found in the vicinity,

two bulls and a cow, have just had tracking collars fitted. This will give Elephants Alive crucial information on their movements, helping to understand what is attracting elephants to the mine, and identifying potential hotspots so that human-elephant conflict can be mitigated.
